

Sharwil Avocados



HAWAIIAN GROWN

Somewhat larger than the Hass, the Sharwil has a skin that will not turn black as it ripens. The fairly dense, buttery flesh has a distinctive flavor, at once nutty and herbal, the pit is smaller than a Hass with nearly double the oil content.

- Sharwil Avocados are in season January through April.
- They can only be sold in non avocado growing states, and states not bordering an avocado growing state ie: California or Oregon.
- Sharwil Avocados peak on 24ct to 32ct.
- Only grown in Hawaii
